To keep it looking fresh, you need to clean and polish your leather couch with the right leather cleaner tools. Leather furniture needs special maintenance. Make sure to regularly remove scratches and dents from your leather couch to leave it looking smooth and brand new.

There are different types of products you can use to clean leather. You can use homemade or store-bought leather cleaning and polishing products. The homemade solution is effective and gentle. It will not harm your leather sofa.

Here's what you need for a homemade best leather cleaner.

What Home Products/Solutions to Use to Clean Leather Furniture

There are many leather cleaning products online. You can find leather cleaning concentrates, leather cleaning lotions, and leather cleaning sprays. You need to find the type that's specifically designed to clean leather couches.

If you don't have liquid cleaners at home, there are other accessible alternatives you can use.

What Tools You Need to Home Clean Your Leather Couch

Here are the tools you will need to clean your leather couch:

1. Three pieces of old cloth. You can use an all-purpose dishcloth and cut it in three.
2. Baking soda or leather and vinyl cleaner
3. Coconut oil

A vacuum cleaner can help a lot with the cleaning. However, it's not crucial, and you can still clean your couch without it.

For people with a vacuum cleaner, the first step is to vacuum the leather couch. Use the smaller attachments to get into the nooks and crannies of the couch. Be as thorough as you can inside the folds. Remember that the sides of the couch can collect dirt, food, and hair.

If you don't have a vacuum cleaner, refer to step 1 of the next section. If you do, skip to step

2.

Step-By-Step Guide – How to Clean Leather Furniture With Homemade Leather Cleaner

Step 1: Take a clean, damp dishcloth and wipe the surface and sides of your couch

Step 2: Sprinkle the baking soda on your couch. Use big quantity for large stains

Step 3: Let it sit for a while so it can absorb the stain

Warning: Keep kids and pets away from the sofa when you're cleaning.

Step 4: Gently wipe off the baking soda using the other dishcloth.

Warning: Check the type of leather on your sofa. You need to be careful because water can discolor unfinished leather.

Step 5: Wipe down all residual dirt or baking soda. For thorough cleaning use your third clean dishcloth.

Step 6: Use coconut oil to remove surface scratches. Use a circular motion similar to how one would use shoe polish.

How to Clean Leather Sofa With a Leather and Vinyl Cleaner

Step 1: Shake well then spray the cleaner directly on the leather surface

Step 2: Gently wipe down the surface with a non-scratch all-purpose cleaning cloth

Step 3: Spray on all surfaces you need to clean then wipe down with the cleaning cloth

How to Polish Your Sofa Using the Best Wipe and Buff Leather Cleaner

We recommend liquid leather sofa cleaners for complete cleaning. Here are the best cleaners your money can buy.

Weiman's leather conditioner

Wipe and buff at the same time. Simple and non-toxic cleaning for finished leather surfaces.

Pros:

- ✓ non-toxic
- ✓ can be used on finished leather covers in cars or bags
- ✓ built-in sun damage protection

Cons:

- ✗ no good for unfinished leather

Step 1: put the spray nozzle in the “on” position

Step 2: spray on a dry clean dishcloth

Warning: Use the product on a small inconspicuous portion of your leather sofa to test. Not for unfinished leather.

Step 3: wipe and buff the leather surface using the damp dishcloth until you get the natural, newly bought shine.
